About Castle Mandawa

Castle Mandawa was a fortress, now converted into a luxurious heritage hotel with medieval turreted towers, palanquin-roofed balconies, blending with modern comforts in old-world rooms. Family portraits, antique cannons and arms add to the charm of this palace where tradition still runs strong. Even time is measured by a different clock... a huge brass gong struck by the resident timekeepers at the fort every hour!

Rooms And Suites

The large and airy rooms of the Castle have been converted into charming, well appointed accommodation, retaining the old flavour using period furniture and local furnishings. No two rooms are alike (there are 70 of them -- **Royal Suites, Luxury Suites, Deluxe Rooms, Standard Rooms**) and yet each of them display the grandeur and the taste of the rulers of the past. A rare blend of modern comfort in medieval surroundings.

In the zenana or women's quarters, one room offers antique murals, another has a marble fountain, while the turret room boasts of walls that are 7 feet thick!

Fine Dining

There are a myriad of dining options at **Mandawa**, whether it is a quiet breakfast on a terrace offering great views of distant temples and cenotaphs, a leisurely lunch in the mural-painted dining room, sundowners sipped in the congenial setting of the **Verandah Bar**, or an alfresco dinner under the stars, entertained by **Rajasthani** folk singers and dancers.

Facilities

Relax in the cosy comfort of the **Diwankhana**, the formal drawing room decorated with family portraits and an array of antique armour.

There is an ayurvedic centre, billiard room, pool table, table tennis, a swimming pool and vintage car rides. From the Castle you can take a walking tour of the painted havelis of some of the leading business families. Some of the better known Havelis of **Mandawa** are **Chowkhani Haveli, Goenka Haveli, Saraf Haveli** and **Ladia Haveli**.

The hotel organizes camel and horse rides, jeep safaris, gala dinners, puppet shows and folk dances, traditional welcome with tilak and garlands, theme weddings, turret dinners and a heritage walk of **Mandawa**.

From **Mandawa** it is also possible to visit the havelis of neighbouring towns of **Nawalgarh, Mukundgarh, Dunlod, Fatehpur, Ramgarh, Laxmangarh, Churu, Jhunjhunu** and **Baggar**. There is the **Blackbuck** sanctuary at **Talchapar** as well as religious excursions to **Salaser Balaji, Jeen Mata** and **Lohagal**.
