The **Laxmi Niwas Palace**, was the principal residence of late **His Highness Ganga Singh**. It was built in the year 1902 was design by the renowned architect **Sir Swinton Jacob** in the **Indo Saracenic** style. The royal palace of **Laxmi Niwas** has a gigantic principal entrance, called the clock tower which is secured by guards and evokes memories of old grandeur and splendour.

This palace was a favourite destination of **Lord Mountbatton, Queen Mary, King George V, King Edward VIII, The King of Greece, M. Clemenceau Prime Minister of France, Viceroy Lord Harding, Viceroy Lord Linithgow, Lord Irwin** and many distinct dignitaries.

Rooms

Laxmi Niwas Palace was the personal residence of **Maharaja Ganga Singhji** of **Bikaner**. Most of the rooms are decorated lavishly using pure gold wall paintings and have painted or carved wood ceilings. The rooms of **Laxmi Niwas Palace** have been painstakingly renovated and refurbished. All modern amenities, including air conditioning, running hot and cold water, refrigerators, televisions, telephones etc. were provided without disturbing the original look of the rooms.

Set amidst vast lush green lawns, lily ponds and fountains the **Laxmi Niwas Palace** is a dream carved out of red sandstone.

On arrival, a short flight of marble stairs takes you to the reception. The lobby is a huge exquisitely carved hall with sandstone arches was once the state drawing room.
