Entrance To The Mayfair Gangtok

Gangtok is the capital and largest town of the **Indian** state of **Sikkim**. It is located in the **Shivalik Hills** of the **Eastern Himalayan** range, at an altitude of 4,715 ft. The town, with a population of thirty thousand has many different ethnicities such as **Nepalis**, **Lepchas** and **Bhutia**. Nestled within higher peaks of the **Himalaya** and enjoying a year-round mild temperate climate, **Gangtok** is at the centre of **Sikkim's** tourism industry.

Gangtok rose to prominence as a popular **Buddhist** pilgrimage site after the construction of the **Enchey Monastery** in 1840. In the early 20th century, **Gangtok** became a major stopover on the trade route between **Lhasa** in **Tibet** and cities such as **Calcutta** in **British India**. After **India** won its independence from **Britain** in 1947, **Sikkim** chose to remain an independent monarchy, with **Gangtok** as its capital. In 1975, after the integration with the union of **India**, **Gangtok** was made **India's** twenty-second state capital.

Today, **Gangtok** is a centre of **Tibetan Buddhist** culture and learning, with the presence of several monasteries, religious educational institutions, and centres for **Tibetology**.
